Other details of the programme	<p>The main aim of the study program is to prepare competent social workers who are able to optimize interaction between patients/clients and their environment enhancing a holistic approach in all levels of health care as well as social care system. The general learning outcome of the study program is graduates' ability to initiate positive changes within the client's micro and macro level social functioning applying knowledge and skills of empowerment for client's participation and decision making in health and social care processes. Study programme teaching methods focus on developing skills of students creativity, responsibility, communication and professional ethics. Subjects of social work practice are included in each semester of study program. Students learn to reflect and analyse their practice experiences during individual and group supervisions.</p>
